GATHER (choose one Gather question to share as everyone settles in to the group time)

- On a scale from 1 to 4, how has your week been?
- Where have you seen God this week?
- What is one joy you want to share with the group this week?

PLANT/GROW

- 1. We started a new series in Harvest inspired by Bob Goff's book "Everybody Always". If you haven't read the book, no problem, you can pick one up or simply listen through the Harvest sermons to get the main points. This first week is about loving people, all people, even the difficult ones.
- 2. Read Matthew 5:38-48. It is easy to love people who are kind, friendly and loving back. How hard is it to love people that are difficult or flat out don't like you? Do you have people in your life like this?
- 3. Be brave. Describe the hardest person you have had to love and it's the last thing you wanted to do?
- 4. Bob Goff writes, "Those who are BECOMING LOVE don't throw people off roofs, they lower them through the roof." His point comes from a story in Luke 5:19 where some men lowered a sick man through the roof. Is there someone in your life (maybe even family) that God is calling you to stop THROWING OFF THE ROOF and start LOWERING THEM to Jesus in prayer/action? Can your Harvest Home Group hold you accountable this week to pray for them?
