

Discussion Guide: Legacy – Marks of a Faithful Church | Discipleship

Begin with prayer

5 min

Check In

20-30 min

Spend a few minutes catching up on life with one another.

- Fruit: what has been bringing you joy lately?
- Thorn: what have you been struggling with lately?
- Vine: how have you seen or been connecting with God lately?
- Bud: what are you looking forward to?

Discuss this week's sermon

10-15 min

- In this week's sermon, discipleship was defined as being shaped relationally. How have you been shaped by the relationships in your life?
- What seemed like the priority in the church that you grew up in?

Open your bibles together

25-30 min

- Read Joshua 4:2-22
- What do you want your legacy to be? What do you hope the legacy of our church will be?
- Read Matthew 28:18-20
- Who was the first person to share the gospel to you? Who have you intentionally shared the gospel with?
- How might discipleship look different in our context than it did in Jesus' day? How is it the same?
- Lo mentioned that throughout the year we will be discussing the marks of a faithful church. What do you think are the marks of a faithful follower of Jesus?
- Read Acts 1:8
- Who would you consider to be in Jerusalem (people who are close), Judea & Samaria (people who are far off and estranged), and the ends of the earth (people groups who are strangers) in your life?
- How are you, or how can you be, intentional about being a witness to these people?
