


**DAY 1: BOZEMAN - YELLOWSTONE NAT'L PARK**  
*August 22, 2021*

Today, fly to Bozeman, MT and meet your Meridian Guided Travel Tour Director. Upon arrival, travel to West Yellowstone, MT, serving as a gateway to Yellowstone National Park since the early 1900's, for a 2-night stay. Experience the **GRIZZLY & WOLF DISCOVERY CENTER**, a wildlife park and educational facility offering visitors a chance to uniquely experience the world of grizzly bears and gray wolves. All the animals at the center are unable to survive in the wild and serve as ambassadors for their wild counterparts. Enjoy a **WELCOME DINNER** tonight with your fellow travelers.

**DAY 2: YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK**  
*August 23, 2021*

Today, enjoy the entire day exploring **YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK**, the world's first national park. Famous for its geysers, hot springs and incredible wildlife including herds of free-ranging buffalo, this amazing place is sure to inspire awe. Your experienced guide will show you the most spectacular sights while also helping you spot some of the park's incredible array of wildlife. See the famous **OLD FAITHFUL GEYSER** shooting a fountain of steam more than 130 feet in the air every 90 minutes. After a full day in the park, enjoy the evening at leisure.

**DAY 3: GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK**  
*August 24, 2021*

After breakfast depart for **GRAND TETON NATIONAL PARK**. Travel past **YELLOWSTONE LAKE**, the largest body of water in Yellowstone as your head south. Wind through this spectacular National Park, home to the youngest peaks in the Rockies and boasting 310,000 acres of lush valley floors, mountain meadows, and alpine lakes. Enjoy time at **JACKSON LAKE LODGE** and maybe try a huckleberry shake, a favorite local treat. Later see the **MORMON ROW HISTORIC DISTRICT**, home to a number of weathered historical structures which serve as an unofficial symbol of the park. Arrive in **JACKSON HOLE, WY** for a 2- night stay. The combined elements of beautiful mountain scenery, old west heritage, and celebrity residents give this small town a unique atmosphere both cosmopolitan and frontier. Tonight, a horse-drawn covered wagon ride will take you to your **CHUCKWAGON DINNER EXPERIENCE**. Enjoy a full evening of great entertainment, western hospitality, and a dinner that will tantalize your taste buds.

**DAY 4: JACKSON**  
*August 25, 2021*

This morning experience an optional Scenic Float Trip along a scenic stretch of the Snake River in the Jackson Hole valley. The calm waters of the Snake provide an idyllic setting to take in surrounding views and to spot wildlife. Later enjoy Jackson Hole with your tour director. Visit the **JACKSON HOLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND MUSEUM**, dedicated to collecting, preserving, and sharing the cultural history of Jackson Hole. From your downtown location, enjoy the remainder of the day at

leisure in one of the worlds most popular resort towns. Maybe visit a western art gallery or check out the local watering holes and maybe see some cowboys.  
*Overnight: Jackson Hole, WY (B)*

**DAY 5: JACKSON - BOZEMAN**  
*August 26, 2021*

After breakfast, depart Jackson Hole today and travel toward Bozeman, MT. Journey along the scenic Teton Pass for an opportunity to view these stunning peaks from the back side. Travel through parts of Idaho and an area known as the Henry's Fork Caldera, formed by an eruption 1.3 million years ago of the Yellowstone hotspot. En route, stop at a **LOCAL MONTANA DISTILLERY** and learn about the production of moonshine using locally grown grains and ingredients and fresh mountain water. Later arrive in Bozeman and check in to your hotel. Tonight enjoy a Farewell Dinner at a popular local restaurant.  
*Overnight: Bozeman, MT (D)*

**DAY 6: BOZEMAN - TRAVEL HOME**  
*August 27, 2021*

Today visit the **WORLD MUSEUM OF MINING**. Butte experienced a century of hard-rock mining and earned the reputation of being home to one of the world's most productive copper mines of all time. The underground mine tour and museum exists to preserve the enduring history of Butte and the legacy of its rich mining and cultural heritage. Later travel to the airport for your journey home with amazing memories of Yellowstone and the Grand Tetons.
